## UK Academy of Chinese Medicine Admissions Information

UK Academy of Chinese Medicine provides two teaching models, namely: the training courses in traditional Chinese medicine(TCM), herbal medicine and prescription, acupuncture and massage; and master's and doctoral degree courses in Chinese medicine and acupuncture, etc.

1. Training Courses in Traditional Chinese Medicine(TCM), Herbal Medicine and Prescription, Acupuncture and Massage:

Designed for beginners and enthusiasts of traditional Chinese medicine, herbal medicine and prescription, and acupuncture and massage. You can apply and start taking classes at any time. The training courses currently offered include:

One-year acupuncture and massage class, £3200; English teaching £3800. The certificate of completion is issued after completing the studies and passing the exam

One-year TCM herbal medicine & prescription class, £3200; English teaching £3800. The certificate of completion is issued after completing the studies and passing the exam.

One year of clinical courses, £3200; English teaching £3800. The certificate of completion is issued after completing the studies and passing the exam.

Traditional Chinese Medicine & Acupuncture Classics Class (Shang Han Lun /Treatise on Febrile Diseases, Jin Gui Yao Lue/ Synopsis of the Golden Chamber, Huandi Nei Jing / Yellow Emperor's Cannon of Medicine 1 year, £3200; English £3800. The certificate of completion is issued after completing the studies and passing the exam.

TCM & Acupuncture Diploma Class , 3-year program with an annual cost of £3,200. The diploma in TCM and acupuncture is issued after completing the studies and passing the exam All the above training courses are accredited by the Acupuncture Society (see the Accreditation Certificate of Acupuncture Society ).



Students who complete their studies and pass the exam can receive a 1-2 year completion certificate ; or a 3-year diploma in TCM and acupuncture , and then directly join the Acupuncture Society without taking the exam to obtain its membership & qualifications to practice acupuncture and massage, and herbal medicine in the UK; It is also possible to open their own herbal and acupuncture massage center. Those who have studied continuously for more than three years and obtained a three-year diploma from our school can directly join The Acupuncture Society or FTCMP; or apply to join other

British acupuncture and TCM associations; simply apply to join one of the following associations to gain the qualification to practice Chinese medicine and acupuncture in the UK, such as: The Acupuncture Society, FTCMP, ATCM, British Acupuncture Council. They can also apply for a master's degree program in traditional Chinese medicine and acupuncture to continue further studies.

Frequency of teaching: 1-2 times per week, 2 hours each time. Teaching time is generally in the

morning: Monday to Sunday, 10 am to 12 am, in a small class face to face or online teaching. There is no limit to the internship time. Specific teaching and internship times and teaching methods should be determined in consultation with the teacher.

2.Postgraduate courses: Postgraduate courses include 3-year master's degree programs , and 3-year doctoral programs. Our partners include Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medical University. Students can choose Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, or Zhejiang Chinese Medical University , according to their interests. Applicants must be non-Chinese nationals (with British or other nationality and passport).

Postgraduate application and enrollment :Start at the beginning of May , and enrollment and completion at the end of May each year.

The school start time : in September.

The conditions for applying for postgraduate studies are: those with a bachelor's degree (TCM, acupuncture and massage, or herbal medicine, or medical related majors) can apply for a master's degree programs; those with a master's degree (TCM, acupuncture and massage, or herbal medicine or medical related majors) can apply for a doctoral degree programs.

Duration of postgraduate study: 3 years for master's degree program. The PhD program is also 3 years long.

Master's and doctoral students take classes and pass all the exams in London in the first year; in the second year, they need to go to Shanghai or Hangzhou, Zhejiang for 2-4 weeks to complete the graduation thesis proposal and internship under the guidance of their supervisor; in the third year, they need to go to Shanghai or Hangzhou, Zhenjiang again to attend graduation thesis defence for 2 weeks . Those who complete three years of study and examinations and pass the thesis defence will be awarded a graduate diploma, master's degree certificate or doctoral degree certificate by Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, or Zhejiang Chinese Medical University .

After graduation, graduates can directly join the Acupuncture Society or FTCMP; or apply to join other British acupuncture and Chinese medicine societies; Simply apply to join one of the following societies to gain the qualification to practice Chinese medicine and acupuncture in the UK, such as : The Acupuncture Society, FTCMP, ATCM, British Acupuncture Council, etc.
